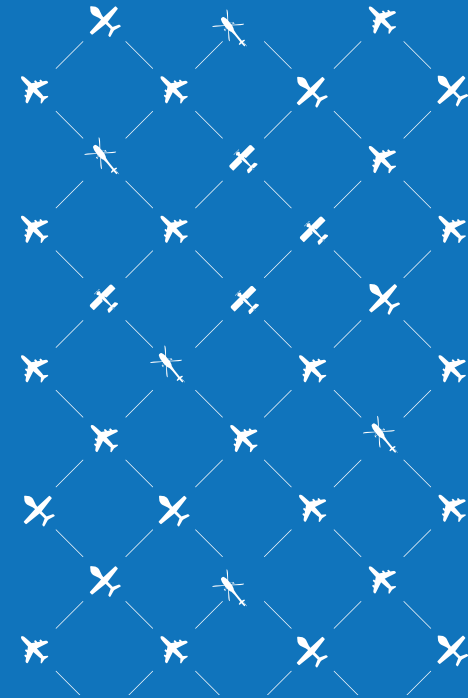

Under the patronage of His Highness Sheikh Mohammed Bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi and Deputy Supreme Commander of the UAE Armed Forces, the first-ever edition of the Abu Dhabi Aviation and Aerospace Week (ADA AW) will run from March 6 to 12, 2016.

The event will run concurrently in Abu Dhabi and Al Ain converging six trade, defence, entertainment, and sports components under its umbrella.

Unmanned System Exhibition (UMEX)

The first Unmanned System Exhibition (UMEX) took place in Abu Dhabi in February 2015, and attracted 33 international and local companies from 13 countries with 7 national pavilions available.

UMEX 2015 attracted such countries as China, the United Kingdom, United States, Canada and Germany, along with South Africa, Italy, France and Sweden as well as Croatia, Spain, Switzerland and Thailand.
